### Testing Eligibility Requirements:

1. Have a clean gi (karate uniform).
2. Attend class the minimum amount of time allotted for that test.
3. The \$15 Testing Fee must be turned in prior to testing.

### The point system:

Each test is allotted a certain number of points. The student begins the test with that many points. For every error made during a test, a point is deducted. When the student runs out of points they fail the test. Students are graded on knowledge and proficiency of technique, focus, and spirit. Intermediate and Advanced students are also required to take a written exam.

### Common things that result in the loss of points:

- Not knowing your Japanese
- Not reading or understanding the test prior to testing
- Not being in proper uniform.
- Showing up late for the exam.
